1. Third Street Corridor Traffic Management - Les MacDonald

The planned installation of a new multi-modal bridge across Paradise Creek at Third Street is anticipated to cause a change in traffic patterns within the Third Street corridor and surrounding area. An assessment of potential traffic management and traffic calming methods was requested by the Mayor and City Council to address the anticipated changes. With the assistance of the Transportation Commission and a task focused subcommittee, four alternative traffic management plans have been developed for consideration by the Council. The Council Workshop Memo included in the packet provides an overview of the development of the four plans along with the public input process undertaken to gather input on potential changes within the corridor.

PROPOSED ACTIONS: Receive the report on the development of the four alternative traffic management plans for the Third Street corridor, consider and select alternatives and direct staff to proceed with the Third Street corridor improvements project or take such other action deemed appropriate.
