Welcome and Attendance

Vice Chair Gilmore called the meeting to order.

Regular Agenda

1. Approval of Moscow Arts Commission January 8, 2019 Minutes (ACTION ITEM)

Clancy moved that the January 8, 2019 minutes be approved; Woolston seconded. Motion carried.

2. Public Comment and Response to Previous Comments (limited to 10 minutes)

Clancy inquired about promotion opportunities on the City's Facebook for the 2019 Summer of Science with the Arboretum. Scallorn said the City's policy for the Facebook is to only advertise City events but that she would be happy to discuss alternate advertising options after the meeting.

Clancy said the Prichard is working on getting grant money to bring Meg Webster, an installation artist, to Moscow to create a sculpture in the Arboretum in 2021. If the installation were to take place it would be advantageous to have a complimentary exhibition at the Third Street Gallery.

3. Third Street Gallery Schedule Approval (ACTION ITEM)

At the January meeting the Commission approved the first two exhibits for the Gallery. Staff has drafted a schedule for the 3rd exhibit, "Photojournalism on the Palouse" with advice from the Committee.

Gilmore presented the exhibit schedule from the packet and asked if there was a motion. Clancy moved to approve the schedule as presented. Caldwell seconded. Vote by Acclamation: Ayes: Five (5). Nays: None. Abstentions: None. Motion carried.

4. Third Street Gallery Prospectuses for "Photojournalism on the Palouse" (ACTION ITEM)

At the January meeting the Commission approved the prospectuses for the first two exhibits. Staff has drafted a prospectus for the 3rd exhibit, "Photojournalism on the Palouse" with advice from the Committee.

Gilmore presented the prospectuses for the show "Photojournalism on the Palouse" from the packet and asked if there was a motion. Clancy moved to approve the prospectuses as presented. Caldwell seconded. Vote by Acclamation: Ayes: Five (5). Nays: None. Abstentions: None. Motion carried.

Reports

1. Artwalk / Events

Scallorn reported that the cover art has been selected, a colored photograph of a potter creating on a wheel. The artist is 16-years old and creates photography and pottery. Cherry will meet with the artist to develop an exhibition for Artwalk.

2. Community Outreach and Programs

Caldwell reported that the Committee members met with Cherry. The goal is to improve what the group does and how to generate an outline on a regular basis of what is discussed so other Commission members can see what is being planned.

3. Public Art

Clancy reported that the tree at C and Main Streets has been removed and the next step is to develop the call for art.

ACLU mural t-shirts continue to be considered and there might be an option to have a screen printer on-site to participate in Artwalk and create/sell the shirts at the event.

4. Third Street Gallery

Clancy reported that the Committee discussed the upcoming Photojournalism and Jazz Festival Poster Art exhibitions.

The reception for the Jazz Festival Poster Art exhibition was a success with a great turn out. The event featured an artist talk with this year's poster designer and Josh Skinner, the managing director for the Jazz Festival.

The schedule for the year is being mapped out with Photojournalism, Artwalk, something to compliment Palouse Plein Air, and then a George Wray exhibition tentatively being considered.
