6. Thorn Creek/Highway 95 Realignment Interpretive Signage Project

This Commission is responsible for the City of Moscow's interpretive sign at the scenic pullout to be constructed as part of the Highway 95 realignment project. The Commission will be working with the Idaho State Historical Society on content and will be discussing at future meetings.

7. Historic District Street Signage

The intersections at the boundary "corners" of Fort Russell will have signage indicating the District name. Street name signs within the District will contain the street name and District logo, designed by Melissa Rockwood.
