4. Consideration of the Annual Bike Tour Date and Venue (ACTION ITEM) – Schott

The Pathways Commission was invited to host their Annual Bike Tour during Palouse Bike Week, September 16th through 21st. Schott has been working with Pedal the Palouse and Rebecca Couch, Director of University of Idaho's Parking and Transportation Services. Each day will feature some smaller observances and a main event; the MPC Annual Bike Tour would be the headliner for Thursday, September 19th.

Gradin has heard from more than one person about this area as well as the lack of safe North-South route for bikers and pedestrians. Gradin requested a copy of Amber Korvalis' presentation about creating such a pathway and Schott said he would try to get one for him. Gradin was also asked about the availability of ADA restrooms along the local pathways.

Dibble will soon be taking the Lead Cycling Instructor test. Denison suggested organizing a women's bike tour after Dibble is certified.
