### **Approval of September 9th Meeting Minutes**

### **Approval of the September 23 Meeting Minutes**

Sophia will be talking to Principal Perrymen to have an announcement in the Daily Bulletin. It was also proposed that we host a basketball event at both schools. This might include buying popcorn from the concession stand so all attending fans can enjoy a free bag of popcorn provided by MYAC with an information brochure. MYAC can also inquire with the school athletic directors to host a short game during half-time and bring some sort of prize (Ex. Shirt and gift card). Jackson will be asking the Logos Athletic Director, and Sophia will be asking the Moscow High Athletic Director. Brandon Proposed that MYAC find a way to help support families in need during the holiday season, this might include working with Winco to have the free turkeys that people are rewarded for spending a certain amount possibly be donated to us and we can distribute them to other organizations. The attending members are considering putting together a float for the U of I Homecoming Parade. If anybody is interested, please contact the group.
