Approval of October 14th Meeting Minutes

The minutes for the October 14th meeting were emailed prior to meeting. Kellen moved and Noah seconded to approve the minutes from the prior meeting. The motion approved unanimously.

Approval of the September 23 Meeting Minutes

The minutes for the September 23rd meeting were emailed prior to meeting. Kellen moved and Rory seconded to approve the minutes from the prior meeting. The motion approved unanimously.

By-Law Amendments Approval

Members were given the chance to review the changes made to the By-Laws set forth by Bill that had been changed since the previous meeting. The major changes were removing the Paradise Creek Regional High School positions and granting them to Logos, meaning that Logos has 6 voting members and Moscow High School has 14. Additionally, the age restriction for voting members has lowered to include sophomores. With the new changes, the final draft was voted on.

Rory Motioned and Kellen seconded to approve the amendments to the By-Laws. The motion approved unanimously.
