### **Approval of October 28th Meeting Minutes**

The minutes for the October 28th meeting were emailed prior to meeting.

Rory moved and Kellen seconded to approve the minutes from the prior meeting. The motion approved unanimously.

### **Recruitment**

6 members from MYAC attended the down-town trick or treat on October 31st to assist Moscow citizens across Main Street. This event went well and members anticipate attending next year, however members will need to find a way to display affiliation with MYAC.

### **Sub Committee Update**

**Turkeys:** Members were assigned teams to visit Moscow's main grocery stores to inquire a donation of 20 turkeys each. The updates from each are as follows: Kellen and Noah went to Rosauers, however the donation manager was not there, they left a letter to be reviewed and will follow up tomorrow. Sam and James went to Winco soon after they received a rejection to the donation as Winco has other donation distributions. Rory went to Safeway and was informed that they would look into inventory and get back to him. Zach and Sophia went to Walmart and were informed they would be contacting Bill with a determination.

After further discussion, teams were asked to follow up with their assigned grocery store. Additionally, Kellen and Sophia have been asked to go to Safeway tomorrow to ask Eric Hanish about setting up a booth in the front this weekend (November 16 and 17) to ask for cash donations or turkey donations on behalf of the Moscow Food Bank. If this is not possible at Safeway, Kellen and Sophia will go to Rosauers. For this, **members will be meeting at Moscow High School after school (3:10) to make posters, please meet outside the office.** There were some ideas for next year: Having a donation box placed in grocery stores, have a turkey pledge and ask stores to match that number, or talking to Winco about having an option for customers to donate their free turkeys to MYAC. Members will be informed via email about the decision of the grocery stores.

**Winter Carnival:** **There will be a subcommittee meeting next Monday (November 18th) at 6 p.m. Members will be meeting at Friendship Square and walking to Brandon's office, because of this, please do not be late.** Some things to be ready by that meeting: size of trailer, generator located, and a quick sketch of what the float might look like. The budget for this subcommittee, as set by Bill, is \$300. The following list of items outlines some of the supplies that will be needed for the float in the Winter Carnival. Power source/ generator, trailer, tree, Christmas toys, streamers, fake snow/cotton, Christmas lights, extension cords, boxes, presents, santa hats.
