Meeting called to order at 6:02 p.m

Approval of October 28th Meeting Minutes

The minutes for the November 12, 2019 meeting were emailed prior to meeting.

Marilea moved and Noah seconded to approve the minutes from the prior meeting. The motion approved unanimously.

Election of Officers

The positions of Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, and Historian ran unopposed. Noah Holzman and Samatha Hammes ran for the position of Treasurer. General Discussion

The downtown city clean up is in April of 2020, many members attended last year and the event was a success. This year members wanted to help out the community and local law enforcement by volunteering to shovel snow. This can be done any day that multiple members are available and coordinated with Jen. Last spring Tammy Poe from Good Samaritans senior home inquired with Bill to have members interview some of the older residents of Moscow. Members have asked to invite Tammy Poe to an upcoming meeting to discuss her ideas on completing this project. Additionally, a parliamentary expert will be asked to present her knowledge on government meeting procedure.
