1. Approval of September 3, 2020 Minutes

Pitman moved approval of the minutes as presented, seconded by Garro. Motion carried by acclamation.

2. PRHLT Letter

Members discussed minor edits to the letter. Bonnar motioned for approval of the letter, seconded by Wolf. Motion carried by acclamation, directing Staff to make edits as discussed and process the letter through Administration.

3. Upcoming Assessment of Fair Housing

Discussion by Commissioners regarding AFH and potential survey options. Members wondered whether mailing the survey is the best way to proceed. Staff was directed to follow up at the next meeting as to the type of information gathering methods that would be acceptable. Force discussed potential areas of concern for mail survey and Wolf, along with other Commissioners, agreed that it may not be the most reliable method.
