 - Ordinance 2021-04: Outdoor Lighting Code for Public Art
With the installation of the recent Homecoming public art project at the north couplet, there has been some discussion among staff regarding the lighting of public art in the City. Currently the majority of lighting is required to be full cut-off with up-lighting only permitted in certain circumstances. The Arts Department requested that the Planning and Zoning Commission review the current lighting ordinance to see if there's a possibility of providing an exemption from the full cut-off requirement for freestanding public art. The Commission conducted a special meeting on January 11, 2021 and reviewed different lighting options at the Helio-terra public art installation. The Commission then directed Staff to prepare an ordinance amending the lighting code to allow up-lighting for public art. The Commission conducted a public hearing on the proposed ordinance on March 10, 2021 and recommended approval to City Council. This item was reviewed by the Administrative Committee on April 12, 2021, followed by a public hearing and City Council approval on April 19, 2021.
