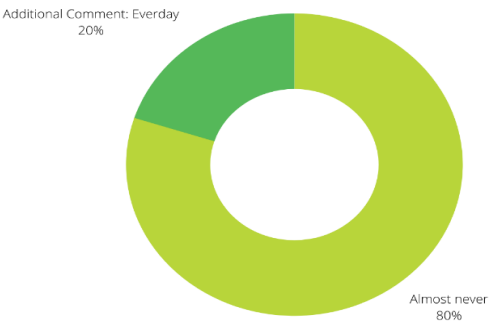

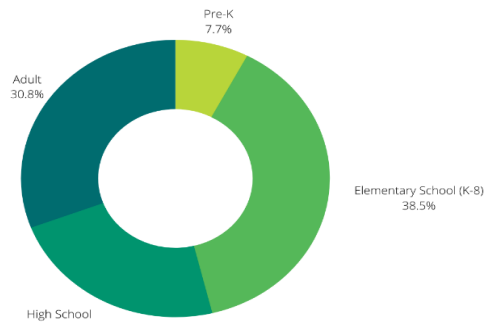

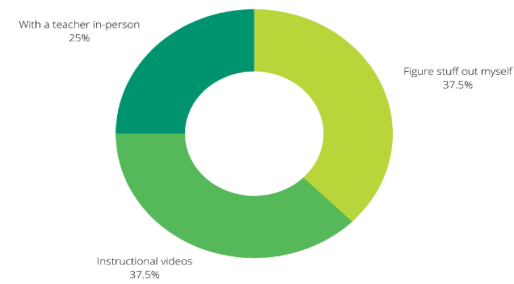
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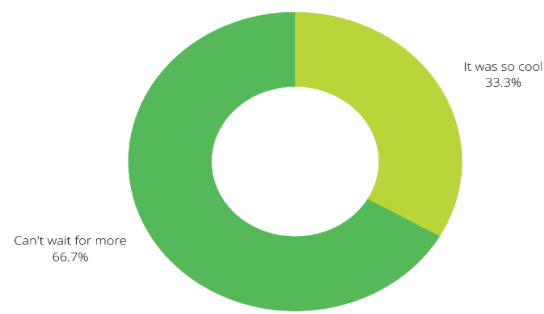
Are there people in your household who want to learn more about making different kinds of art? What are their age groups?



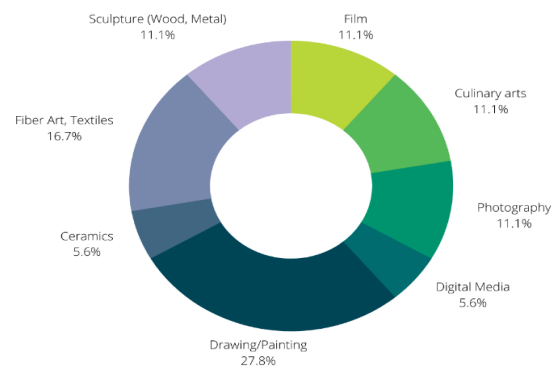
What is your favorite way to learn about art?

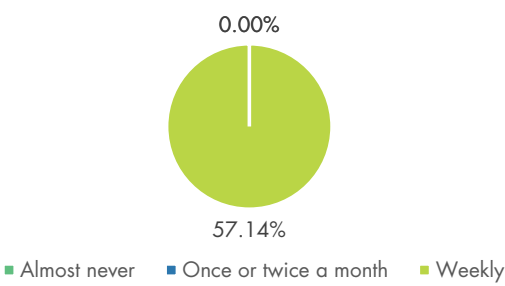
