Staff will present background and authorized uses of federal funding from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). The City of Moscow was allocated \$5,528,399 of ARPA funding and has received the first tranche of \$2,764,200. The second tranche of an equal amount will be issued to the City in the summer of 2022. Staff has prepared recommendations and alternatives for City Council consideration for potential uses of these ARPA funds. In addition, staff will present a funding model for addressing the Strategic Plan Tier One Major Challenge Area of Inadequate Law Enforcement Radio Infrastructure. Staff will be seeking Council direction on those recommendations and alternatives.
