REGULAR AGENDA

1. Approval of April 22, 2021 and June 2, 2021 Minutes

Porter moved for approval of the minutes as presented, seconded by King. Vote by Acclamation: Ayes: Unanimous (7). Nays: None. Abstentions: None. Motion carried.

2. Discussion on Library Interpretive Sign

The Commission conducted a site visit on April 7, 2021 to discuss the location of the Library interpretive sign and subsequently decided on a tentative location. The Commission has since received feedback from the Library Director who is proposing an alternative location slightly to the north of the Commission's preferred location.

The Commissioners discussed the Latah County Library Director's request to place the Interpretive Sign left of center, in relation to the front of the original Carnegie building.

Taylor moved to accept the proposed placement, seconded by Magee. Vote by Acclamation: Ayes: Unanimous (7). Nays: None. Abstentions: None. Motion carried.

3. 2021 Orchid Awards

Discuss possible Orchid Award recipients for 2021 and the Orchid Awards event.

The Commission took a tour of the 1912 Center's recent restoration work, which would be under consideration for the 2021 Orchid Award.

Reese distributed handouts featuring the ten (10) potential awardees to be narrowed down from and finalized at the next meeting. Tong and Landis gave an update on the award event planning process. Porter discussed the proposed program and will work with Staff on the final layout design. Porter had also requested the previous Commission Chair Wendy McClure to be the event speaker.

4. Future Interpretive Signs Locations and Content

Discuss the possibilities for interpretive signage in Friendship Square, Fort Russell, or other locations.

Magee gave an update on the interpretive sign for Friendship Square. The plan is to work with Staff on the initial design, which would feature multiple photographs and minimal text.

REPORTS

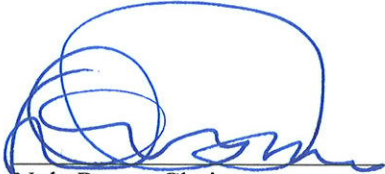
