1. Latah Human Rights Task Force Report

Faunce reported the task force continues work on the MLK breakfast. There are no new details regarding a speaker for the breakfast. The task force is hoping to have an in-person event for 2022.

2. Sheikh Award

Kathy Sprague was the 2021 Sheikh Award winner. She was recognized for her work in the community as well as for setting up the Eastside Food Bank. The event was zoomed. The engraved plate for East City Park with Kathy's name is currently being manufactured. It will be attached to the rock monument when it is completed.

3. Restorative Justice Event

There was no update.

4. Andrew Becker Memorial Artwork Panel.

Awwad-Rafferty has been selected for this panel and has not heard from the selection committee regarding the status. The committee will be contacted for an update.

5. Food Insecurity

The Westside Food Bank still needs volunteers. There are about 30 former Hillcrest motel residents who were asked to leave when the motel sold. Some community organizations are helping these individuals. Some residents have been relocated to Lewiston.

7. Moscow As an Inclusive Community.

There was discussion about what things would help to make Moscow an inclusive community:

- Non-gender bathrooms. The City of Moscow has made quick fixes to make restrooms gender-neutral. Those restrooms needing major fixes will be filtered through the City budget and will take time. All future bathroom construction by the City will be gender-neutral.
- Bias Reporting System. There was discussion regarding coordination between the reporting systems for UI and the City to ensure accurate statistics. UI receives 2-3 reports a month. The development of a student consent form to share between UI and the City was discussed. Fry will contact City Attorney Mia Bautista about sharing the City's information for statistical purposes.
