1. Discuss Climate Action Plan Draft Progress

Kelli Cooper will present progress on the Climate Action Plan.

ACTION: Receive the report and provide feedback.

Kelli says it was brought up through email about adding a human rights section. Tina suggested adding an adaptation section which would include human rights.

Tina suggested adding zoning and transportation to the mitigation section. Kelli mentioned that the Plan was written to be very broad in what would be included.

Nancy Chaney suggested adding climate to one of the conditions to the conditional use permit. Kelli says she will look at adding a general category that climate could fall under.

Kelli will meet with Paul Kimmel, Avista, to look into all electric rates.

Kelli will make it even more clear that there are two separate goals in the plan; community goals, and city operations goals.

2. Announcements/Other Business

Mary with Citizens Climate Lobby is looking for collaborators on an Earth Day event. This would include writing letters to the legislature, more local actions, etc.

Tina says that during an affordable housing meeting last year, and there were women from PNNL (Pacific Northwest National Laboratory) and they are looking for low- and middle-income organizations to help provide new insulation and new siding.
