2. Student Presentation from Palouse Prairie Middle School – Greg Pierce

Students from Palouse Prairie Charter School presented possible solutions to help housing affordability in Moscow and the surrounding areas. Some of the proposed ideas included housing subsidies for renters, child care subsidies, rent control, employer incentives for flexible work schedules, amending the Zoning Code, and educational outreach. Commissioners commented on the presentation and commended the students on their thorough research and hard work.
