3. Consideration of Additional Parkland Dedication for Phase 1 of the Edington Subdivision (ACTION ITEM) – David Schott

On April 22, 2021, the Parks and Recreation Commission considered and recommended approval of deferring 1.02 acres of parkland dedication for phase 1 of the Edington Subdivision to phase 2 of the development based on the preliminary plat. The preliminary plat and the annexation were approved by City Council on June 7, 2021. The applicant, BBC LLC, has submitted an application for a preliminary subdivision plat to increase phase 1 by an additional 10.50 acres. The proposed addition to phase 1 of the Edington Subdivision falls under the requirements of the parkland dedication requirement of City Code.

PROPOSED ACTIONS: Recommend approval of deferring the additional 0.69 acres of parkland dedication for phase 1 of the Edington Subdivision until phase 2 of the development; or take other such action deemed appropriate.
