2. Update regarding the Potential University of Idaho Historic District (ACTION ITEM)

He will also email copies of OSU's information and the 52-page application they submitted for their district. 5. Future Interpretive Signs Locations and Content (ACTION ITEM)

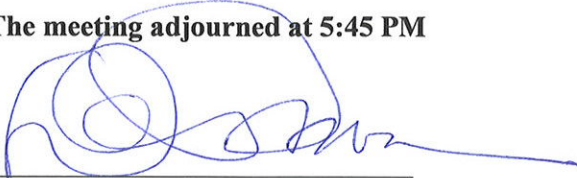
