1. Latah Human Rights Task Force Report – Joann Muneta

The task force is still accepting nominations for the Rosa Parks Achievement Awards. The deadline for submissions is January 5th. Submissions may be 1-2 pages and can be submitted to Joann Muneta or by mail to P.O. Box 8613, Moscow, ID 83843. The MLK Breakfast will be held on January 21st at 9:30 a.m. at the Moscow Middle School. The first 100 attendees who register will be admitted to the event. It will be livestreamed for all others. Dr. Scott Finnie, Eastern Washington University, will speak on community and human rights growing together.

2. Commissioner Terms

3. Restorative Justice Forum

This forum will be moved to winter (possibly February). A confirmed date will be announced at another time. There was discussion regarding possible topics such as the controversy surrounding the mask mandate and the homicide as well as the national press exposure and community healing.

4. Future Human Rights Forum

The Commission will be looking at ideas for forums for next year as well as a theme for Inclusive Communities Month. There was discussion about possible topics such as what are human rights in relationship to shared values and defining socialism and communism.

5. Renaming Indian Hills Park

There was no report.

6. Reproductive Rights and Human Rights

Stevens had one-to-one conversations with individuals regarding this topic including Latah County Prosecutor Bill Thompson. Thompson stated that those in power to prosecute healthcare workers who provide care have no interest in pursuing prosecution. There is an initiative which is a grassroots campaign. Gritman Medical Center will meet basic standards of care on this issue. If someone needs help getting care, Stevens is available to help.

7. Mental Health Crisis Team

The ad hoc committee met. The Women's Center has shared their event promotion plan with the committee.

9. Report on Hate Incidents / Moscow as an Inclusive Community

The only updates were online death threats of those people who have been harassed due to the homicide.
