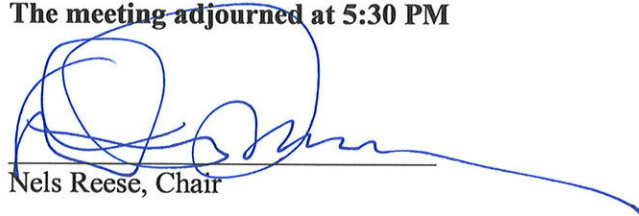
support the creation of a National Registry of Historic Places District on the University of Idaho campus. The Commission were supportive and offered to help, as needed.
