3. Review Process for Large Retail Establishments – Cody Riddle

Staff will provide an overview of the review process and ordinance provisions regulating large retail establishments in Moscow.

Riddle reviewed the process and design manual for incoming Large Retail Establishments. Applicants are required to have a neighborhood meeting before submitting for Administrative Review by the City. A Traffic Impact Study is required with the application, as well as a report on any impacts on current infrastructure. The parking requirements are based on the square footage of a proposed building. There was a conversation regarding climate impact and sustainability options to possibly add to the design manual in the future.

4. Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) Update – ITD Staff

Staff from ITD will provide an update on current planning efforts impacting Moscow and the surrounding area.

- Riddle informed the Commissioners that ITD consultants were recently in town interviewing stakeholders regarding several proposed projects. The Commissioners talked about highway crossings.

- Engineering is in negotiations for Right-of-Way with one property owner for the Public/Polk Street project, which is slated for construction next year. Staff will provide more information at the next meeting.
- The City-wide slurry projects have been completed.
