The meeting was called to order at 5:02PM

1. Approval of Pathways Commission June 13, 2023 Minutes (ACTION ITEM) – Tanya Denison

Presentation of minutes for approval.

PROPOSED ACTIONS: Approve minutes as presented; approve minutes with amendments; or provide staff further direction.

Brown moved to approve the minutes as presented. Dibble seconded. Roll call vote. Ayes unanimous. Motion carried.

2. Public Comment and Response to Previous Comments (limited to 15 minutes)

3. Consideration of the Pathways Commission Banner (ACTION ITEM) – David Schott

The Pathways Commission will review staff edits to the display banners.

PROPOSED ACTIONS: Approve the display banner; or take other such action deemed appropriate.

Heckendorn suggested increasing the font size. Denison suggested changing the background to white, so the banner can be viewed more easily.

Dibble moved to approve the banner with the font size increased and background lightened. Heckendorn Seconded. Roll call vote. Ayes: unanimous. Motion carried.

4. Consideration of the Annual Fall Pedestrian Tour (ACTION ITEM) – Tanya Denison

The Pathways Commission will discuss the date, time, route and theme for the annual pedestrian tour.

PROPOSED ACTIONS: Approve the date, time, route and theme for the 2023 Annual Pedestrian Tour; or take other such actions deemed appropriate.

Bacon suggested meeting at the Ghormley park shelter and taking a tour around the University of Idaho Recreation center, onto the Paradise path and towards the new children's educational bicycling area.

Bacon motioned for the Moscow Pathway's Commission pedestrian tour to be hosted on September 19, 2023, in lieu of the September 12th, 2023 meeting. Dibble seconded. Roll call vote. Ayes: unanimous. Motion carried.

5. Consideration of the September 2, 2023 Farmers Market (ACTION ITEM) – Tanya Denison

The Pathways Commission will discuss staffing the Farmers Market. The theme approved previously was public outreach for the upcoming annual pedestrian tour. The commission will also discuss any support needs from staff leading up to the Farmers Market.

Chastain, Dibble and Denison stated they would setup at the farmers market. Support needs requested as follows: stickers, banners, fliers, coloring books.

Heckendorn makes a motion to approve the theme and staffing. Brown seconded. Roll call vote. Ayes: unanimous. Motion carried.

Dibble felt people were not given enough time, that the event was too short notice, however the turnout was decent. Heckendorn and Dibble enjoyed the farmers market and said it was busy. Denison made fliers regarding the upcoming bike tour.
