1. Approval of Pathways Commission January 10, 2023 Minutes (ACTION ITEM) – Tanya Denison

David Herbold (Moscow) inquired about the unpaved portion of Adams street located between B Street and C Street, known by locals as “Deadman’s Hill”. Herbold advised he had heard that someone was trying to buy the city right of way to the unpaved walking path and was wondering if pedestrians would no longer have access to the walking path.

3. Planning and Coordination of Bike Month, Bike to Work Day, Annual Bike Tour, and May 20th Farmers Market (ACTION ITEM) – Tanya Denison
