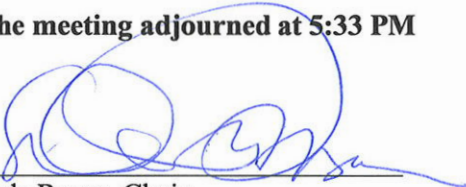
REPORTS
