The Commissioners will make their final decision by the regular meeting scheduled in September. There was a conversation about potential awards ceremony speakers.

4. University of Idaho Historic District Update (ACTION ITEM)

A discussion about working on the University of Idaho Historic District and the preliminary research being done by students.

Dulce Kersting-Lark provided an update on the University of Idaho (UI) Historic District. There was a workshop last year that was well attended and UI is educating students on how to survey. The Idaho State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) requested the UI Historic District be the whole campus, not just select buildings. Students are still working on the surveying of campus.

The Commission will work on ideas to contribute to the America 250 project, which will be on July 4, 2026. There was a discussion about applying for a Certified Local Government (CLG) grant through SHPO.

The Commission will continue to discuss the work being done on brochures to be provided to community members and visitors.

The Commission talked about potentially editing the draft script to fit a brochure. Next meeting there will be a discussion about important points to inform the community about the three different districts.
