3. Capital Improvement Plan Update – Cody Riddle

Staff will provide the Commission with an update on anticipated transportation projects included in the City's 10-Year Capital Improvement Plan.

Riddle introduced and reviewed the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for FY2025-FY2034 and offered to answer any questions from the Commissioners. Many of the planned projects are at least partially funded by grants and the Grants Division will be applying for more grants to cover numerous others.

The Commission applauded the City's initiative to plan for future projects, and wondered if the Parks Division had considered planting trees in advance of some of the projects to allow for more growth in the meantime. There was a discussion about some of the parks projects that are also in the CIP, as well as the benefits of roundabouts versus traffic signals.

- Hajda provided an update from Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) on the Hwy 95 realignment project.
- ITD plans to upgrade the traffic signals within the City of Moscow.

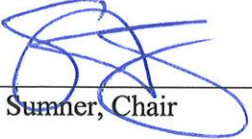
Pathways Commission has planned a walking tour on October 8, 2024 at 5:00 PM, starting at Kiwanis Park.
