4. Idaho Walk Bike Alliance Presentation – Nancy Nelson

Nancy Nelson will provide an overview of the organization's activities and lead a discussion on how the Commission might coordinate transportation planning efforts and potential grant applications in the future.

Riddle introduced Nancy Nelson, from the Idaho Walk Bike Alliance, who described what their organization does and their purpose for Idaho. The Commissioners introduced themselves and what alternative transportation activities are important to them. Nelson talked about the grants that Moscow and other communities have access to regarding alternative transportation methods. The Alliance puts on a Transportation Policy Conference every year in Boise. The Idaho Walk Bike Alliance encourages individual and organizational membership donations.

The Commission talked about the impact that the improvements on Mountain View Road and the Highway 8 underpass has had on the community. There was a discussion about future projects and potential improvements that the Commissioners would like to see prioritized. The Idaho Walk Bike Alliance is also working on a grant for educational purposes. Staff will add an item to a future agenda to discuss a recommendation to support the organization.
