3. South HWY 95 Pathway Extension - Bid Results & Contract Award (ACTION ITEM) - Luke Hajda

The South HWY 95 Pathway Extension's Project scope is to connect an existing shared-use path on Reisenauer Rd (adjacent to the Schweitzer Engineering Laboratories property) north to an existing sidewalk section on US-95. The project is to construct a ten-foot wide shared-use path from Reisenauer Rd to the existing sidewalk. The City sent out a semi-formal request for bids on July 17, 2026, and the Engineer's Estimate for construction was \$145,449.00. Bids were opened July 23, 2026. The City received one bid in the amount of \$141,263.70 from Motley-Motley, Inc. of Pullman, WA. A bid tabulation is included in the packet.

PROPOSED ACTIONS: Recommend acceptance of the bid from Motley-Motley, Inc, award the contract in the amount of \$141,263.70 and authorize staff approval of construction change orders in an amount not to exceed 10% of the contract amount, or provide staff with further direction.

4. Cooperative Agreement for Future Traffic Signal Installation (ACTION ITEM) - Nichoel Baird Spencer

In 2025, the City of Moscow entered into a development agreement with the developers of the SOMO development in south Moscow, which included the collection of the developers' proportionate share fee toward the cost of the future traffic signal installation at the intersection of Somo Drive/Reisenauer Road and U.S. Highway 95. The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) has requested that the City enter into an agreement to convey the collected fees to ITD at the time the signal is installed. Staff has prepared an agreement for the Council's review approval.

PROPOSED ACTIONS: Recommend approval of the Cooperative Agreement, or provide staff further direction.
